Here are the classes you can enter – have a go!

Narcissus Classes

1. Large single-flowered daffodils – 1 bloom
2. Double-flowered daffodils – 1 bloom or stem
3. Multi-headed daffodils (jonquils etc – several blooms on one stem) – 1 stem
4. Miscellaneous – miniature daffodils etc – 1 bloom or stem

Other Horticultural Classes

5. Tulips – 1 bloom
6. Tulips – 3 blooms (mixed), 1 vase
7. Any other cut flower (bulb or herbaceous) (one variety), one or more stems – 1 vase
8. Flowering shrub – one or more specimen stems (one variety), 1 vase
9. Foliage pot plant, 1 pot
10. Flowering pot plant, 1 pot
11. Bunch of mixed herbs, 1 vase
12. Rhubarb, forced or unforced, 3 stems
13. Any fruit or vegetable (other than rhubarb), fresh or stored

Non Horticultural Classes

14. Spring flower arrangement (any flowers), 1 vase
15. Flowering shrub arrangement, 1 vase
16. A garden in a teacup or mug

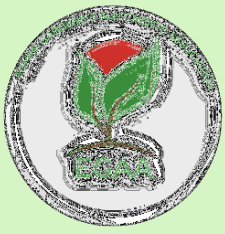
Cookery Classes

17. Cake – Simnel
18. Cake – Fruit
19. Marmalade or jam – 1 jar

Only one entry per member per class. Blooms, plants, veg and fruit must be from your own garden/allotment. Pot plants must have been in your possession for at least 3 months. Please provide your own vases (a jamjar is fine). Classes 1-13 judged on horticultural excellence, classes 14-16 judged on aesthetic presentation.
