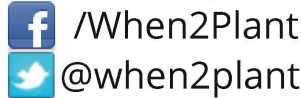
## Legend

## Companion planting

### Good combinations:

Potato	with marigolds, peas, beans, garlic, and sunflowers
Strawberry	with marigolds, bush beans, lettuce, spinach, garlic, barage
Endive	with fennel
Asparagus	with tomato, parsley and marigolds
Eggplant	with marigold
Cauliflower	with oregano
Beans	with celery, sage, carrot, cauliflower, lettuce and potato
Beet/Beetroot	with onions, bush beans, dill, celery, kohlrabi and garlic
Dill	with carrot, leeks, turnips, sage, fennel and celery
Peas	with beans, carrot, leeks, turnips, sage, fennel and celery
Kohlrabi	with celery
Cucumber	with dill, garlic, celery and fennel
Melon	with garlic and nasturtiums
Leeks	with beans, carrot, peas and turnips
Radish	with parsley
Turnips	with beans, carrot, leek and parsley
Celery	with leeks, cabbage, and basil
Lettuce	with chervil, dill, fennel, carrot, turnips and garlic
Spinach	with celery
Chili peppers	with basil, garlic and chives
Tomatoes	with parsley, basil, garlic, chives and marigolds
Broad beans	with dill and savory
Onions	with carrot, beet, tomatoes, chamomile, savory and parsley
Carrot	with lettuce, peas, dill, chives and garlic

### Bad combinations:

Potatoes	with tomatoes, rosemary, mint, thyme and chamomile
Strawberries	with cabbage
Cauliflower	after spinach
Beans	with fennel, onion, shallots, garlic, and gladioli
Peas	with onion, garlic and rue
Lettuce	with parsley
Tomato	with fennel and kohlrabi
Onions and garlic	with beans and cabbage
